Sundays in Saint Michael Hall

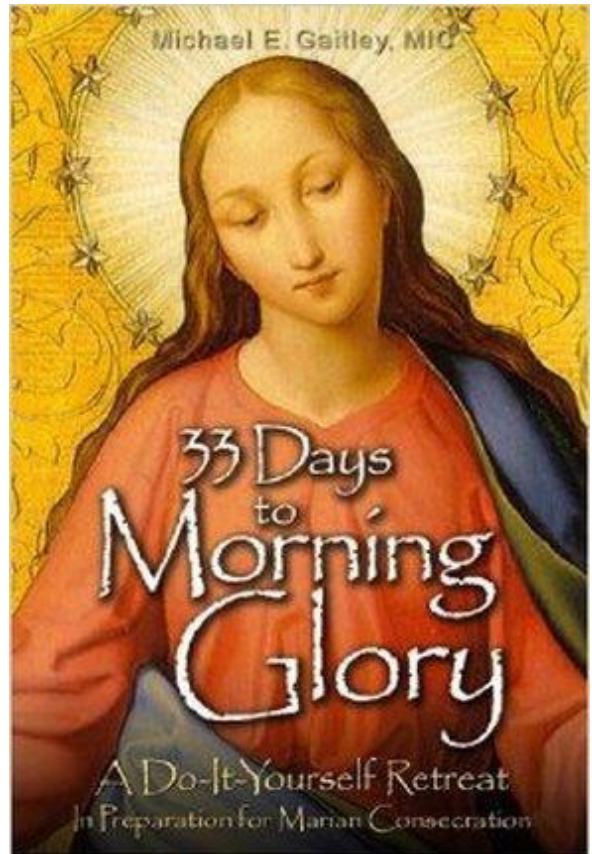
4:00 – 5:00 pm starting April 14th.
